



Richard Enright Scholarship

Under the auspices of the North Shore Chapter of the American Guild of Organists, a scholarship fund in memory of Richard G. Enright (1923-2016) is being established. Annual earnings from this fund will be used to provide scholarships to aspiring organists attending Pipe Organ Encounters (POEs) around the country. These summer organ camps have introduced thousands of young people to the “King of Instruments” over the past three decades.

A beloved teacher, Dr. Enright was a charter member of the North Shore Chapter, a past Dean of the Chapter, a faculty member of the School of Music at Northwestern University for 35 years and Chairman of the Church Music and Organ Department from 1969 to 1989. He was a prominent organist at several churches in the Chicago area.

The scholarship will be sheltered by the AGO New Organist Fund and administered by the AGO national office in New York. A minimum of \$15,000 is required in order to activate the scholarship. Contributions of all sizes are needed in order to achieve this goal.
